



LEAGUE RULES

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

Each player must sign a waiver before the first game. If you add a player to your team throughout the year the player must sign a waiver before they play, even if it is only for one game.

Please supply your score to the league convener or game official at the end of your game.

THE TEAM

6 vs 6 Volleyball: Each team would field 6 players per set. The total number of players in a team (including substitutions) could be up to a maximum of 9 players.

Each team is allowed to play one (1) player less than the minimum and still not be disqualified. Any players less than that and the team may be in forfeiture. The final decision on whether teams play one another with less than minimum players is decided among the team captains and is relayed to the league official present.

Every player is required to wear their top and bottom jerseys during their games.

Default: If a team is unable to field the minimum requirements within 10 minutes of the start time, then that team is deemed to have forfeited their game. The opponent will automatically score a 25-0 win for all three sets.

THE GAME

Duration of match (70 minutes):

Each match is scheduled 10 minutes for warm up, please come on time. Furthermore, matches are limited to whichever comes first, either the 60-minute duration expires or when all three sets are played.

All three sets are always played, with all three being played to 25 points where a team must win by two (2) points to a maximum overall point score of 29 points.

If play is in the third set, and time expires, the team leading will be declared the winner of that set.

The Basics

1. There is a maximum of three hits per side.
2. A player may not hit the ball twice in succession.
3. A block is not considered a hit.
4. The ball may be played off the net.
5. A ball touching a boundary line is good.
6. The ball should be played between the ends of the net. Any ball touching outside of the ends of the net is considered as out of bounds.
7. legal hit is contact with the ball by a player using any part of their body, which does not allow the ball to visibly come to a rest.
8. If two or more players contact the ball simultaneously, it is considered one play and the players involved may not participate in the next play.
9. Playing the ball with the foot (except on serve) is legal. Any contact with the foot must be controlled.

Balls that touch anything on the roof are still in play. The play is dead if it touches a side wall.

The Serve

1. A player may serve no more than 1 step in front of the service line.
2. Team captains will play rock-paper-scissor for first serve. And the loser of the previous set will get next set's first serve.

The Rotation

1. Liberos are allowed
2. No cap to the amount of times a player can serve

League scoring system:

Game Win (2/3 sets)	2 points	
Game Loss	0 points	
Set Win	2 points	Maximum of 8 points per game.
Set Tie	1 point	
Set Loss	0 points	

Playoff Tournament:

Playoffs is a single-day single-elimination tournament hosted on the weekend of the 9th week. Exact day and location will be disclosed closer to the date.

The regular season is used for the seeding, so try your hardest during the season!

(Game 1) 1st vs 8th

(Game 5) Winner of 1 & 2

(Game 2) 3rd vs 6th

(Game 7) Winner of 5 & 6

(Game 3) 2nd vs 7th

(Game 6) Winner of 3 & 4

(Game 4) 4th vs 5th

All games are best of 3. Except finals are best of 5.

All registered participants are permitted to play in the playoffs.

Any substitute players that have been brought in to fill in the space of registered participants are only permitted to play in the playoffs if they have played at least three (3) regular season nights. This is to avoid teams bringing in "ringers" for the playoffs.
